<u>Christmas Performances</u>

This year the children will be performing a production of 'Bethlehem's Got Talent' for our Christmas play. Therefore, we have decided to put on two performances - one on Monday 16th December at 1:30pm for all families who have children in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2. The second will be on Tuesday 17th December at 9:30am for our families who have children in Year 3 to Year 6.

Both performances will be identical with all age groups performing in both. If you have children in both key stage 1 and 2 please could you only attend one performance so that the hall does not get too overcrowded and everyone has the chance to see their child perform.

We must also ask that only two people attend the performance per family please. I hope you understand that we are simply trying to ensure that all families get a chance to attend working with the small space that we have. Thank you for your co-operation.
