










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Book Exchange

Fruit for snacks at playtime

The government-funded free fruit and vegetables for playtime snacks is provided for children in Reception to Year 2. If there are any leftover, this is always offered to our older children but they are welcome to bring in a piece of fruit or veg to have at playtime if they would like.

Leave of Absence & School Attendance

All leave of absence requests must be made in writing at least two weeks before the start of leave. Forms are available from the school office and website. Please note family holidays <u>will not</u> be authorised during term time. New regulations were brought in on the 19th August 2024 - please see below for details:

A new 'National Framework' has been introduced to bring consistency in the use of Penalty Notices across England. A new national threshold will be met if a pupil has been recorded as absent for 10 sessions (5 school days) within a rolling 10-week period. Penalty notices will be issued by the Local Authority. For a first offence, the Penalty Notice will be £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days and rising to £160 if paid after 21 days. For a second offence the amount will be £160 per parent, per child. A third penalty notice cannot be issued within a three-year period and therefore prosecution will be considered should this occur. Should a Penalty Notice remain unpaid then prosecution for the
















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substantive offence of 'failing to secure the regular attendance of a child of compulsory school age' will be considered.

Please note that any holidays taken within term-time from 19th August may be liable for these Penalty Notices regardless of when the holiday was booked.










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Dates for Diary
